

Complaints procedure Consumer

Article 1: Definitions

- 1. Training institution: STC Next, established in Rotterdam;
- 2. Complainant: a participant in a course or training course or a parent or (other) legal representative of a minor participant;
- 3. Complaint: complaint about the organization or content of the education or training at STC Next or the way in which (if applicable) this is provided.
- 4. Complaint does not mean a complaint as a result of sexual intimidation, discrimination, aggression, violence, bullying or intimidation. A separate complaints procedure applies for this.
- 5. Complaints also do not include a complaint about the content or assessment of an exam. The complainant submits such complaints to the Examination Board.

Article 2: Filing a complaint

- 6. The complaint must be submitted in writing, motivated and signed to the management of STC Next, Soerweg 31, 3088 GR, Rotterdam.
- 7. There is no right of complaint against a decision of general application.

Article 3: Handling the complaint

- 8. The management confirms receipt of the complaint to the complainant within 5 working days.
- 9. The management provides the complainant with all relevant information with regard to the complaint that the management has at its disposal.
- 10. Within a maximum of 3 weeks after receipt of the complaint, the management will give the complainant the opportunity to explain his complaint. A report of this explanation is drawn up and sent to the complainant.

Article 4: Judgment

- 11. Within 3 weeks after the hearing, the management will make a decision in response to the complaint. The decision is communicated to the complainant in writing and includes at least the findings, conclusions, responses and handling of the complaint.

Article 5: Effective date

13. This regulation came into effect on January 10, 2022.
